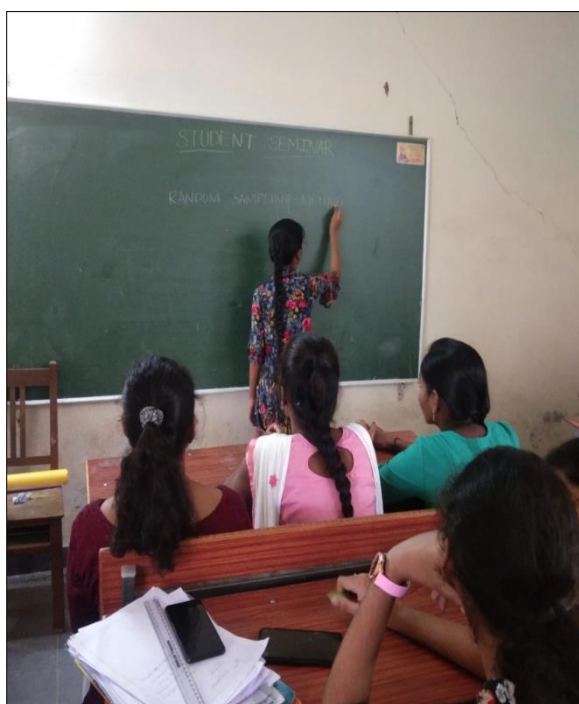


STUDENT'S SEMINAR

The in charge of the department Dr. G. Shyamu, faculty members Dr. B. Nainadevi and V. Rama acted as facilitators of the seminar.



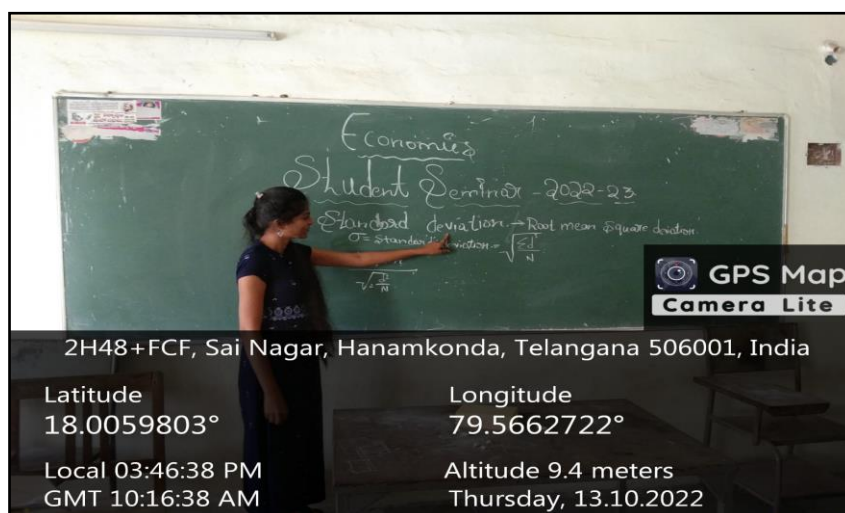

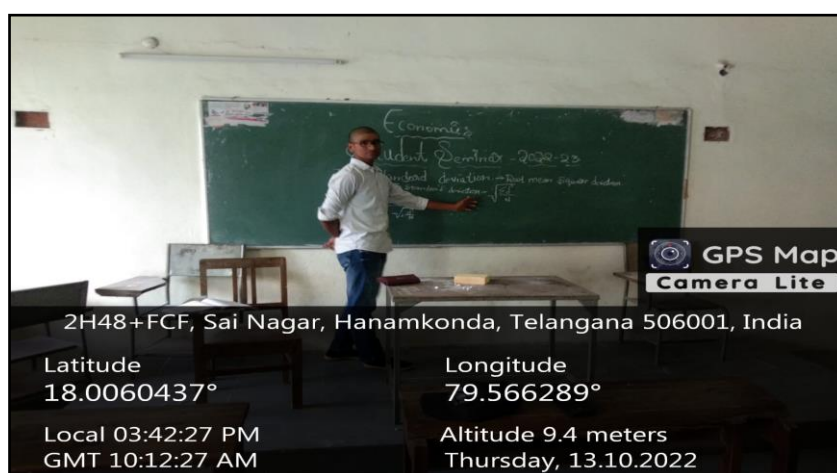
13.10.2022
