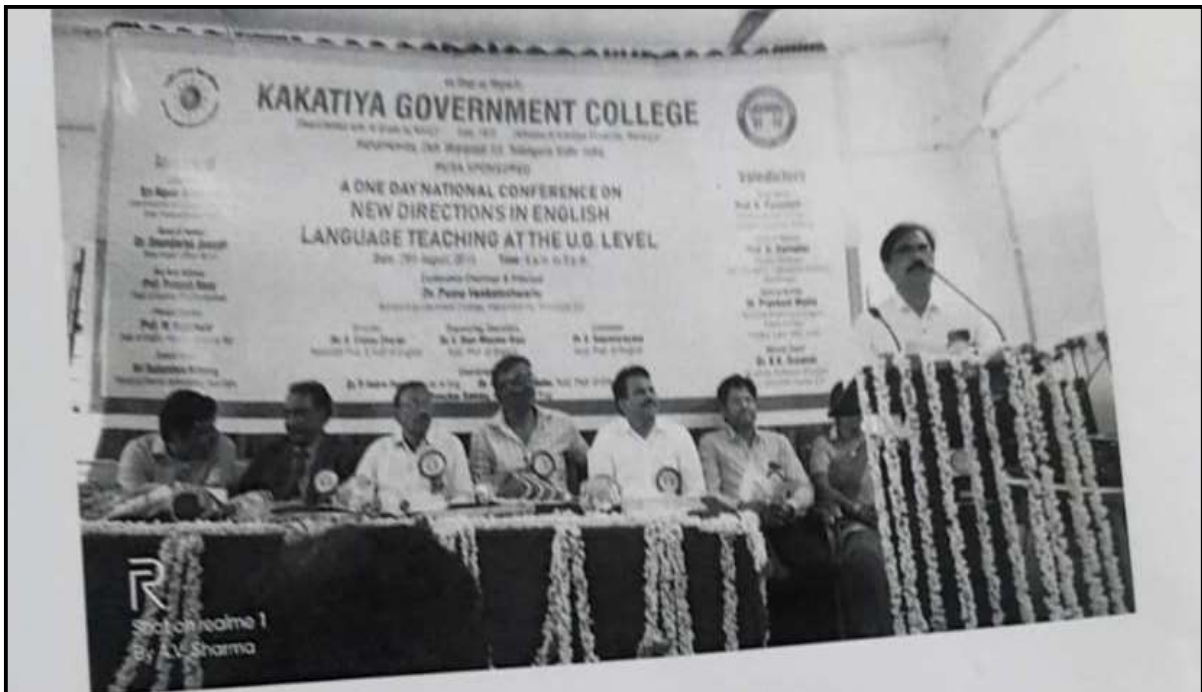





## **WORKSHOP ON CREATIVE WRITING**

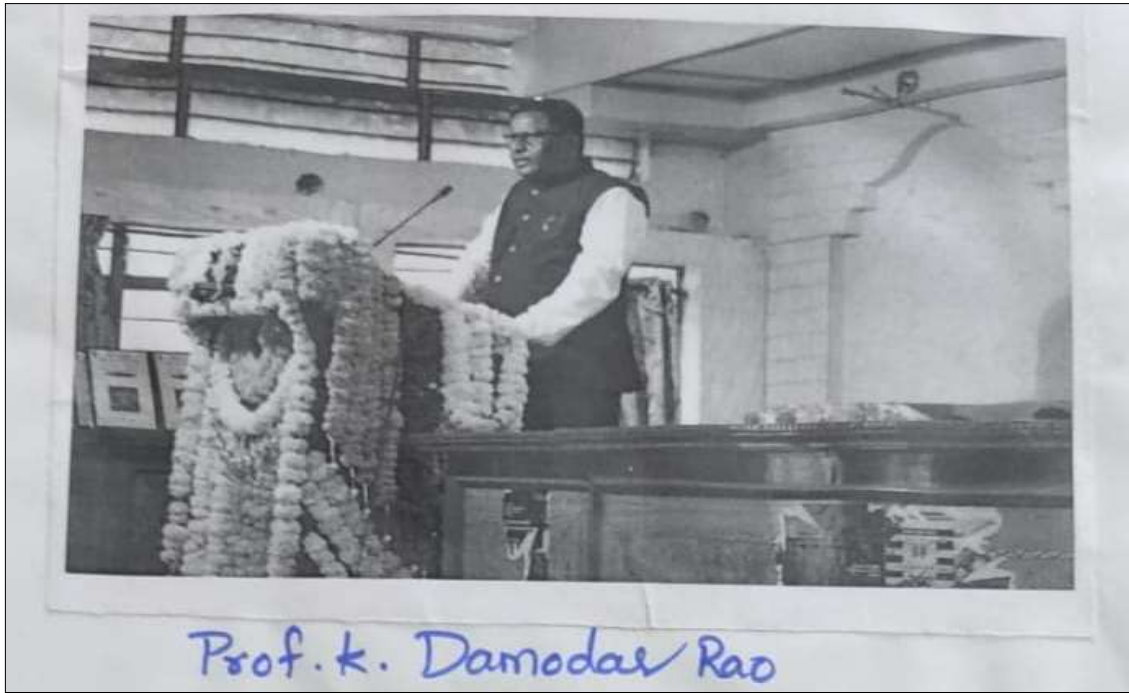
**11-09-2019**

## Departmental Resolutions


