**INTRODUCTION**

## **Introduction**

Nearly 70 percent of India's population lives on around 120 rupees for a day, according to World Bank data. The country, the world's second-largest producer of wheat and rice after China, is also home to a quarter of the world's hungry. Helping the poor has always been on the ruling government's agenda since independence. In India, the government has launched several schemes over the years to help alleviate the hunger problem. Despite all its economic prosperity in certain areas, India lags behind on many social parameters. One of them is Low Price Meal Scheme i.e. named as Annapurna in Telangana State.

The Annapurna scheme is to provide a meal with low price for benefit of the poor people and the same was started recently in Greater Warangal Municipal Corporation. In Telangana State, initially the Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation has started Rs. 5/- per a meal programme for poor people on 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2014 at 5 centers in Hyderabad and named as Annapurna. It was collaborated by Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation and Hare Krishna Movement Charitable

Foundation's Akshaya Patra. Now it is extended to 150 centers in twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad.

The Greater Warangal Municipal Corporation has also inspired by the Annapurna scheme from the Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation and started Annapurna Scheme at 8 centers in Warangal, Hanamkonda, and Khazipet. The Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister Sri K Srihari launched the programme on 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2017 at MGM Hospital, Warangal. On the said occasion the Hon'ble Deputy CM has unveiled a logo of the GWMC. The MLAs Smt Konda Surekha and Sri Aroori Ramesh, the MLCs Sri Konda Muralidhar Rao and Sri P Rajeshwar Reddy, Commissioner of Police G Sudheer Babu, District Collector Amrapali Kata, Municipal Commissioner Shruti Ojha and others have attended to this programme. Later, the Officials had inaugurated food stall at other centers in Tri-Cities of Warangal, Hanamkonda, and Kazipet.

The main objective of the Annapurna Scheme is to provide a meal for Rs. 5/- for poor people in Tri-Cities. A large number of people, who come from villages to Warangal every day for seeking various works and some, are visiting the hospitals and other tasks. The food stalls were being placed at labouraddas, markets, hospitals and other places for the convenience of poor. A healthy meal is provided for Rs. 5/- to benefit the poor people. The programme has already been implemented successfully in Hyderabad. The State Government decided to introduce the Annapurna Scheme in Greater Warangal Municipal Corporation Area and consulted to the Hare Krishna Foundation and the Hare Krishna Foundation has agreed to take up the programme in Warangal Urban also.

In this programme, the Greater Warangal Municipal Corporation is providing financial assistance of Rs. 19.25 per plate meal in this programme and the Hare Krishna Foundation would be taking care of the transport and cooking the food. The General Insurance Company donated Rs. 7 crores towards the construction of the kitchen.

The aim of the Greater Warangal Municipal Corporation is to provide food for 50,000 of people per day in Warangal Urban through this Scheme in future. At present, the Greater Warangal Municipal Corporation is providing meals to 4,500 of people per day through this programme.





### **Details of Low Price Meal Schemes in the Other States:**

The present study basically aims to know the progress of the low price meal programmes in nearby states which was initiated by respective State Governments. The programmes are successfully running and there is a huge response from the common people in some States.

Close on the heels of Amma Unavagam (mother restaurant) scheme of Tamil Nadu which has become a huge success, the Andhra Pradesh Government has launched the Anna NTR Canteen, a populist scheme aimed at providing the subsidized meal to daily wage workers, small-time employees and poor people in the state.

#### **Andhra Pradesh:**

The Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu formally inaugurated the Anna NTR Canteen at the interim Secretariat complex at Velagapudi, which is part of the new capital city of Amaravati. The Anna NTR Canteens are providing breakfast, lunch, and dinner to the poor people at heavily subsidized rates.

#### **The menu of the Anna NTR Canteens:**

**For breakfast:** Idli, Upma and Pongal, each for Rs 5/- per plate

**For lunch:** Sambar rice for Rs 7.50/- per plate and Pulihora (lemon rice) and curd rice for Rs 6.50/- per plate.

**For dinner:** Menu comprises two chapatis with vegetable curry for Rs 7.50/- per plate.

#### **Tamil Nadu:**

The Government of Tamil Nadu has implemented the scheme of low price meal for the people which are named as Amma Unnavagam (Amma Restaurant). The Amma Unnavagam (Amma Restaurant) began with a vision to provide low-cost meals for the public at large in 2013, and despite doubts about its sustainability, it has grown to a chain of over 200 outlets across Tamil Nadu's urban

centers and prompted visits by officials from other states, which are keen to replicate the model.

### **The menu of Amma Unnavagam :**

#### **For breakfast:**

Rs.1/- per each Idli and Pongal

#### **For lunch:**

Three varieties of pre-mixed rice

- 1) Sambhar Rice and Curd Rice – Rs. 3/- per plate
- 2) Lemon Rice --- Rs. 3/- per plate
- 3) Curry Leaf Rice-- Rs. 3/- per plate

#### **For dinner:**

Two Chapatias with Complimentary Dhal -- Rs. 3/- per plate.

### **The Objectives of the Study:**

1. To know how the programme is benefitting poor people.
2. To know about the possibilities to launch the scheme in our college
3. To know is the food provided is healthy and hygienic
4. To know the other views of beneficiaries

### **The Research Methodology:**

Research methodology is the specification of the method of acquiring the information needed to the structure or to solve the problem at hand.

It is the pattern of the framework of the project that stipulates what information is to be collected, from which source and by what method.

Sample survey method of investigation is the beneficiaries were done. A questionnaire was prepared to collect the opinion of the beneficiaries and related issues. The team visited various Annapurna Stalls and Cooking Sections in Warangal Urban and collects the related information and data through the beneficiaries and Employees of Hare Krishna Foundation.



### **Role of the Hare Krishna Movement Charitable Foundation:**

The Hare Krishna Foundation has taken two projects in Telangana State which are Akshaya Patra and Bhojanamrita (Annapurna). The Akshaya Patra vision is “No child in India shall be deprived of education because of hunger”. It means no children should stop their education due to their poverty. It is also providing hygienic food to the children who are attending Anganwadi Centers.

The Hare Krishna Foundation initially comes forward to collaborate with the Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation for implementing Annapurna Programme in Hyderabad. Thereafter, the Hare Krishna Foundation extended their support to start the Annapurna Programme in Warangal Urban.

The Hare Krishna Foundation appointed 150 employees for preparing and supplying of food to Akshaya Patra Programme and Annapurna Stalls in Warangal Urban.

## **CHAPTER-II**

# **IMPLEMENTATION OF ANNAPURNA SCHEME IN WARANGAL URBAN**

### **Implementation of the Scheme in Warangal Urban**

The Annapurna programme is successfully running in 8 centers in Warangal Urban. It is providing hygienic lunch for 4,500 people per day in Warangal Urban. Each center is serving 480 minimum meals per day. The staffing pattern of the

center is one Supervisor and two Helpers. The Greater Warangal Municipal Corporation is deputed one sweeper for each Center for the purpose of cleaning and helping to the Staff of Annapurna. The timings of this programme are from 12.00 noon to 2.00 pm. every day and there is a special lunch on every Monday.

This scheme is being availed by different kinds of people who are mainly auto drivers, attendants of patients in hospitals, labour, students and some people who are visiting City for various works every day.

The well-furnished kitchen of Hare Krishna Foundation is located in Enumamula Market. It is maintained very neatly and Rice and Dhal are prepared with steam cooking. Every day, 50 employees start their work for preparing food from early morning from 4 am onwards.

**Financial Support:**

The Greater Warangal Municipal Corporation is paying an amount of Rs. 19.25 np per meal to the Hare Krishna Movement Charitable Foundation and beneficiaries are paying an amount of Rs. 5/- per meal and the same is directly being received by the Hare Krishna Movement Charitable Foundation. In this view, Hare Krishna Foundation is getting an amount of Rs. 24.25/- np per meal.

**The opinion of the Beneficiaries:**



The opinion of women workers and auto drivers is as given below:

- They do not need to spend time in preparing lunch at their houses.
- It is monetarily benefited them.
- The food provided is sufficient for intake with only Rs. 5/- per meal being paid.



Beneficiaries of the Annapurna

The opinion of the attendants of patients in hospitals and labour as follows:

- They are saving money by having lunch in this centers and no need to bring lunch boxes from their houses.
- It is hygienic and healthy food.
- The students said that many of them come from the villages and are utilizing the scheme with minimum expenses. They have opined that it is very useful to them.

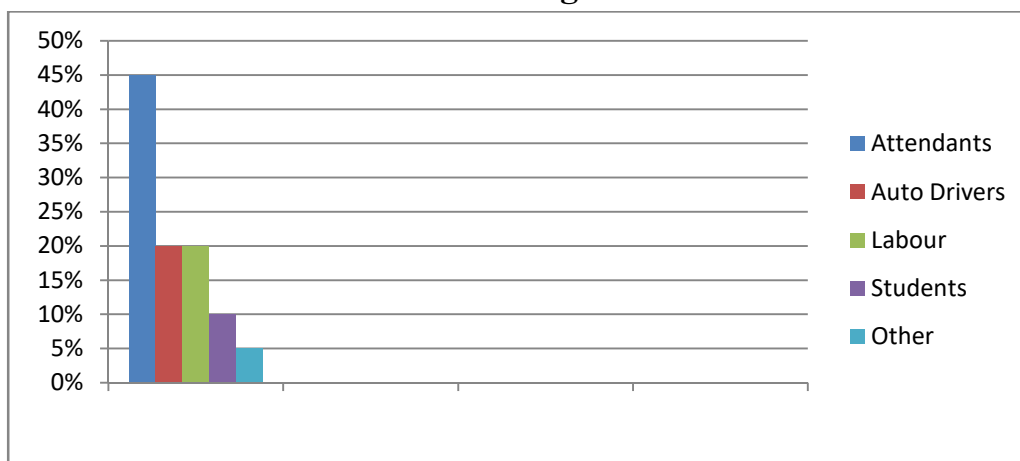

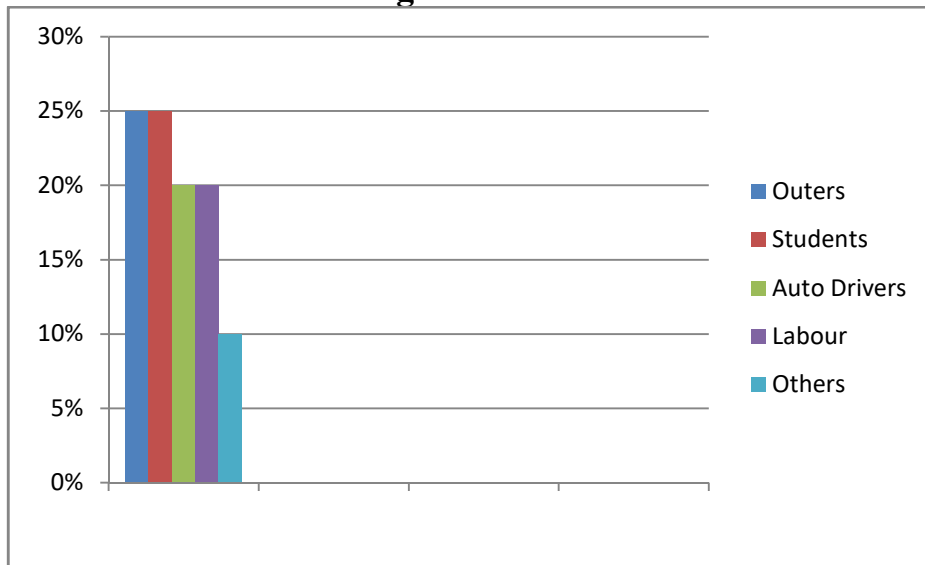

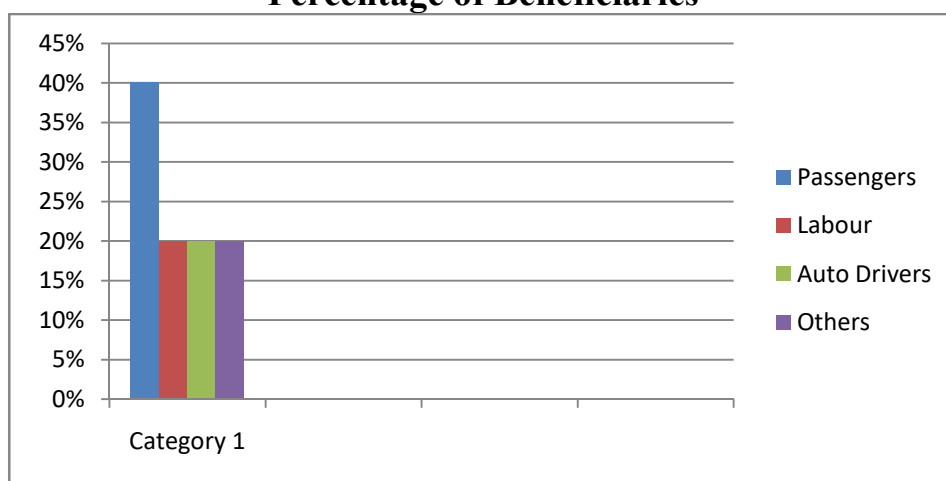

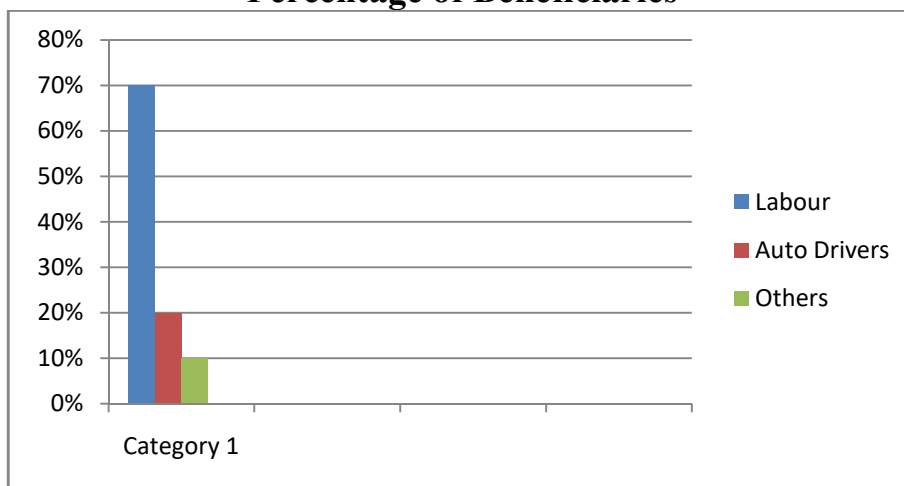

**Percentage of Beneficiaries**



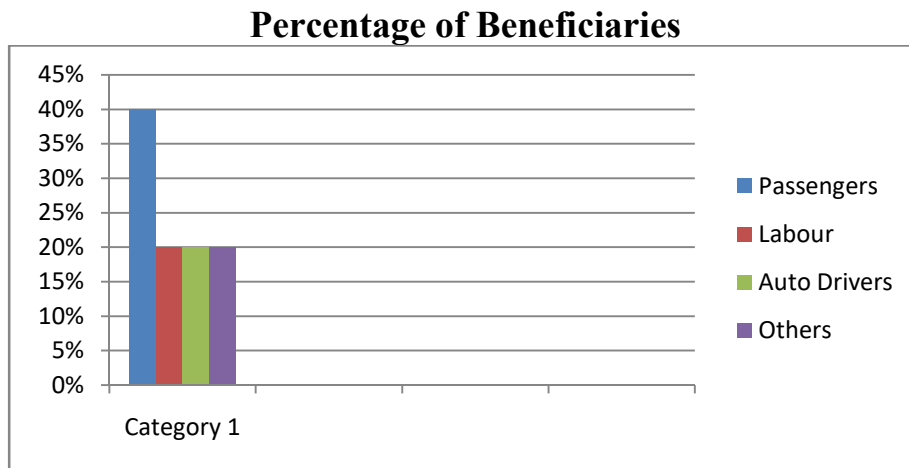

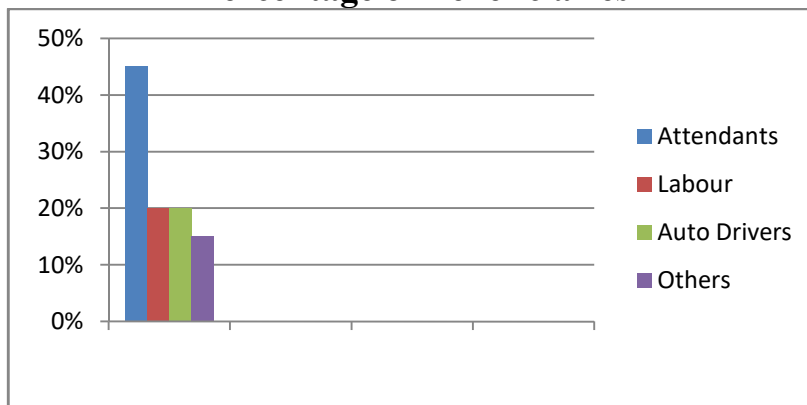

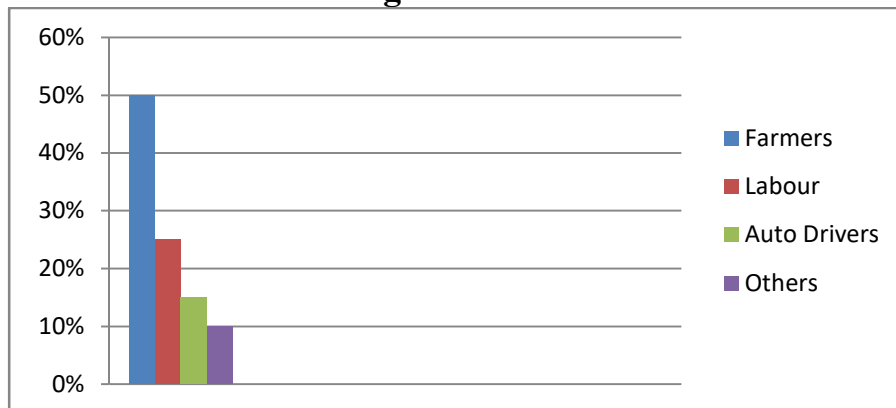

Kadiyam Srihari garu was kind enough to launch an Annapurna center that would benefit the students of Kakatiya Government College Hanamkonda.

**Suggestions:**

- The Annapurna Stalls should be launched in more Centers in Warangal Urban.
- If it is possible to open in other cities and towns in Telangana State, that is very useful and helpful to the people.
- Water is insufficient to the people so Municipal authorities must help in this regard.
- If it is possible the scheme should be extended to provide curd or butter milk every day.
- If it is possible this programme may be extended to breakfast and dinner as in Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh.
- The Annapurna Stalls should be launched in the premises of all Government Degree Colleges and Junior Colleges where the strength is more than 500.

- If it is possible the scheme should be extended to provide Sambar every day.
