All Principals, of the Government Degree Colleges in the Telangana State are requested to furnish proposals for starting of the new courses with Medium for the academic year 2017-18 to RJDCE Warangal by **23-01-2017** and RJDCE is requested to scrutinize the proposals & submit with specific recommendations to the HOD by **30-01-2017** so as to enable the department to consolidate the same and furnish to the Government.

- d) No financial commitment to the department
- e) No further sanctioning of the posts for the newly introduced courses

2. UG Restructured Courses

- f) Demand from the students and parents
- g) Availability of infrastructure (class rooms, labs etc.)
- h) Availability of faculty
- i) No financial commitment to the department
- j) No further sanctioning of the posts for the newly introduced courses

3. UG Conventional Courses

- a) Demand from the students and parents
- b) Availability of infrastructure (class rooms, labs etc.)
- c) Remittance of corpus fun
 - i) B.Sc (BZC) Rs. 7.5 Lakhs
 - ii) B.Sc(MPC) Rs. 6.4 Lahs
 - iii) BA & B.Com Rs. 0.6 Lakhs

(Waving of the corpus funs is not under the purview of the CCE)

The Principals are informed to submit the proposals by specifying the groups, medium(i.e., E/M, T/M, U/M) & intake of the students to RJDCE, Warangal and the RJDCE is informed to scrutinize the proposals before forwarding them to Commissioner of Collegiate Education, Hyderabad, along with recommendations.


Further all the Principals are informed that no proposals for starting of New Courses will be accepted after the expiry of date. Hence they are instructed to send the proposals in time to RJDCE and no proposal will be accepted without the recommendation of RJDCE.
