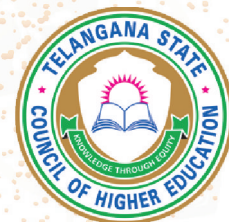
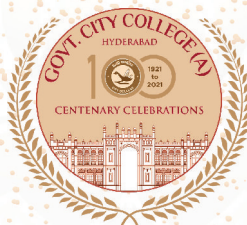

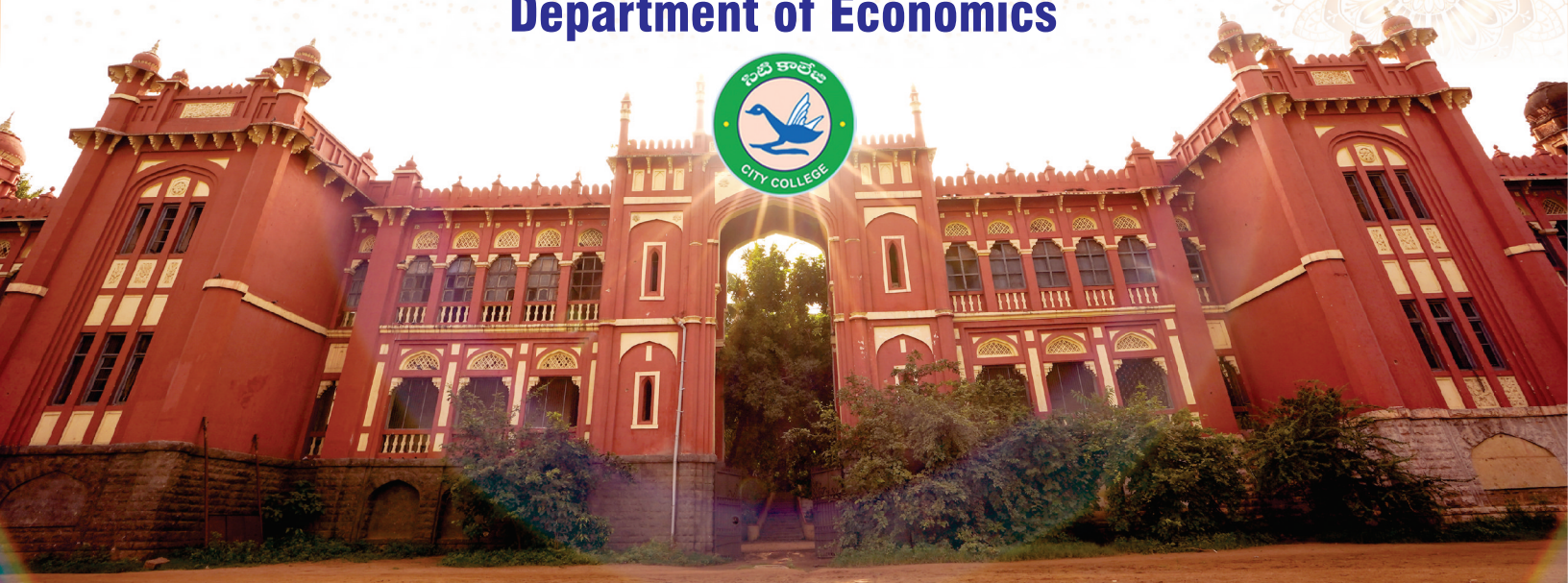

About the College:

Government City college (A), serving as the unique Undergraduate and Post-graduate autonomous educational Hub of Telangana was founded by the last Nizam, Mir Osman Ali Khan in 1921. The campus spread on picturesque 6 acres green pastures operates in one of the oldest Heritage structures providing education to approximately 4,500 students in varied streams. The college is recognised as the most preferred U.G. college for its urban location, enchanting and ethnic Heritage building and gigantic alumni strength comprising of distinguished personalities settled in India and abroad as well. The college has carved-out a niche for itself by successfully heralding subsidized government education to the needy sections of the society visualizing a dream of emerging as one of the premier educational institution in India as a part of its Centenary celebrations year — 2022.

About the Department:

The Department of Economics was established in 1968 and the Chair of Head of the Department of Economics was launched as a part of 1968 Telangana Movement for intensifying agitation for separate Telangana state. Prof Jayashankar Garu, the Father and Architect of Telangana State was the first H.O.D. The department has completed 50 years of establishment and educated many batches of students pursuing economics as core subject at the undergraduate level.

The department has launched B.A. (Honours) programme in Economics apart from conventional CBCS course. The department offers Economics subject in 18 combinations with both Social sciences and Physical sciences under the "NEW BUCKET SYSTEM" launched by CCE for the benefit of the students.

About the Seminar:

The State of Telangana as the 29th state of Indian Republic was formed on 2nd June, 2014 resulting from about 60 years of continuous struggle based on Separate State ideology comprising of equal distribution of water resources, employment and income resources.

The budding economy of Telangana with Hyderabad Metropolitan city as its capital carries a promising future in the fields of IT and ITES sectors, Production and Export sectors.

The state of Telangana becomes noteworthy in the context of acquiring special status as the second highest contributing state of about 12.05% to Indian GDP. It is one of the fastest growing states notifying annual average growth rate of 13.90% over the last five years.

The state of Telangana handled Corona-virus pandemic-2019 by prioritizing agriculture, and allied activities thereby reducing imbalance caused by pandemic related lower outputs in industrial and service sectors.

The economy of Telangana with rich natural resources and skilled Human Resources needs extensive research towards innovating new opportunities of growth eliminating ever rising challenges. Being the youngest economy of India, there is an equal need of dissemination of knowledge and information to the nurturing stake-holders of Telangana state. In this context, a Two-day National Seminar is initiated by the Department of Economics with the following objectives and expected outcomes.
