The Government of Telangana has been honouring the meritorious Teachers working in the Universities and the Affiliated Colleges in the State with State Awards on the Teachers Day every year i.e., on 5th September. The award carries a gold plated Silver Medal, a Certificate and a Cash Award of Rs.10,000/-.

Vide reference 2 and 3 read Government has issued Orders and Guidelines for the selection of Teachers, Librarian, and Physical Director in Affiliated Govt. Degree Colleges, Pvt. Aided/Unaided (NAAC Accredited) Colleges and Universities in the State of Telangana. The schedule for submission and processing of proposals for the State Awards 2019 is as follows:

3	Committee comprising of CCE and Dean, CDCs of 6 State Universities of Telangana select eligible teachers from Affiliated Colleges and forward to State Level Committee on	10-08-2019
4	State Level Committee selection of teachers from Affiliated Colleges and Universities on	17-08-2019

PROCEDURE:

1. The Principals of all Government and Private Aided Degree Colleges and NAAC accredited, UGC (2f) recognized Private Unaided Colleges in the State are requested to form a College Level Committee to nominate teachers eligible under the said criteria for State Awards 2019 and fill the "Teachers Performance Reports" based on the academic database of teachers of their respective institutions. The nominations (with all evidences) should be submitted at **erstwhile District ID colleges** as per the schedule without fail. (As per the Annexure enclosed).
2. The names of the teachers who have been awarded punishments or against whom charges are pending should **not** be recommended.
3. The nominations (**Booklets in A4 Size**) received within the stipulated time should be scrutinized by the committee with Principal, erstwhile ID College as the Chairman and Principals of all constituent colleges as members with meticulous care.
4. The Committee should carefully scrutinize the proposals item wise in a very objective manner guided by the academic records available.
5. The number of teachers to be recommended from each college should be restricted as follows on the basis of the strength of the regular teaching staff working.

Up to	25 Teachers	01 Nomination
Up to	50 Teachers	02 Nominations
Above	50 Teachers	03 Nominations

The Principals are requested to submit the nominations in the Formats prescribed to the concerned erstwhile ID College following the instructions scrupulously. The Principal, erstwhile ID College is requested to recommend the nominations of the Principals under their jurisdiction along with the copies of material evidence and send to O/o CCE within the stipulated timelines.
