NATIONAL CADET CORPS (NCC), 55/10(T) BN COY ARMY WING

National Cadet Corps Army Wing Senior Division was established in the month of November, 1992 as a fully fledged company with the in take of 137 cadets under the unit of 10(A) BN NCC, Warangal Group. This company was under in charge of Mr. D.Venugopalam, Lecturer in Mathematics as a “Care-Taker” for the academic year 1992-93. He was selected for commissioning in the NCC and was Commissioned on 22nd February, 1993 as 2/Lt from Officers Training Scholl (OTS) Kampptee, Maharashtra. The strength of the cadets has been raised from 137 to 160 cadets in the academic year 2002-2003. Subsequently, the strength of the cadets further rose from 160-200 in the academic year 2003-2004. Present strength of NCC cadets are 150.

Mr. D.Venugopalam, Associate NCC Officer has been continued up to 2011. Than after Dr. V.Rajaiah rendered his services as “Care Taker” from 2011 to 2016. After that Lt.K.Sukumar appointed as trained ANO in 2016 and continued upto June, 2018. After transferred earlier ANO, Lt.Dr.J.Chinna have taken the charge of NCC activities in 30th June 2018, and he rendered his services upto 26, July 2018 after transfer on ODB, the care taker Sri. G.Srinivas Goud appointed in 2018 continued upto 5th September, 2019, again Lt.Dr.J.Chinna has taken charge from Srinivas Goud on 5th September 2019.

INCEPTION OF NCC

The NCC has its genesis in the ‘University Corps’, which was created under the Indian Defence Act, 1917, with the aim of making up the shortages of the Army. In 1920, when the Indian Territorial Act was passed, the ‘University Corps’ was replaced by the University Training Corps (UTC). In 1942, the UTC was renamed as the University Officers Training Corps (UOTC). The need of young boys and girls to be better citizens and future leaders of our great country in the all walks of life, including defence forces, was rightly realized by our leaders. A committee under Pandit HN Kunzru was set up in 1946 at the behest of our first Prime Minister, Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru

The NCC came into existence on 16 July 1948 through the NCC Act XXXI of 1948 under the Ministry of Defence with the following aims:-

1. To develop character, comradeship, ideals of service and capacity for leadership in the youth of the country.
2. To stimulate interest in the defence of the country, by providing service training to youth, and
3. To build up a reserve to enable the Armed Forces to expand rapidly in a national emergency.

TRAINING ACTIVITIES OF NCC

Drill, shooting, physical fitness, map reading, first aid, gliding/powered flying, boat pulling, sailing and camp training form part of Institutional Training. Camp training constitutes the most vital part of the NCC training. In camps, young cadets get the thrill and joy of outdoor and community living. Besides, all India camps such as National Integration, Leadership, Nau Sainik, Vayu sainik, Army Attachment, Republic Day and Independence Day Camps in which cadets from all parts of the work together contribute greatly towards promoting national integration. These camps widen the horizon of the young cadets and provide them an opportunity to forge bonds of national brotherhood. These camps have abridged the cultural gaps, broken regional, religious and language barriers and have brought the youth closer to each other.

The camp training gives these; young boys and girls thrills and joy of outdoor lie and also assists in developing camaraderie, team work, group cohesion, qualities of character and leadership, self confidence and self reliance, since a cadet may stay for two/three years in the NCC, in either Junior Division/Junior Wing, Senior Division/Senior Wing, therefore, we endeavor to give an experience of attending a camp to at least 50% of the cadets each year.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES BY NCC

The purpose of organizing these activates is to make our young people conscious and sensitive to the needs and problems of their fellow countrymen as also to contribute meaningfully to enriching the community life. As an effective youth organization with an eye on the future of the country, the NCC devotes a great deal of time and effort on activates that assist the community, providing succor and relief to the needy during natural calamities. The NCC has been in the forefront in rendering assistance to the needy. Some of the major activities are blood donation, anti-dowry anti-leprosy and anti-drug programmes, tree plantation, eye donation and construction of roads. The NCC has laid great stress on ecology and conversation with developing waste lands and forestation are receiving great attention.

CONCLUSION

The National Cadet Corps has come a long way from its modest beginning in 1948. Its flag has gone to several countries carrying with it the message of goodwill and universal brotherhood, a message dear to the founding fathers of our nation, today, the National Cadet Corps, armed with the motto of 'UNITY AND DISCIPLINE', is steadily marching forward to meet the leadership challenge of the twenty first century.
