These are some of the most instructions that every single candidate should be keeping in their mind for staying away from the problems.

- The student's details form should only be filled once by a student
- There is no limit when it comes to choosing – Colleges and University
- Students have permission to apply with more than one combination

Eligibility Criteria

As such, there is no eligibility criterion for pursuing studies under DOST. The simplified aspect is that the student should have passed 10+2 from a reputed and recognized board or equivalent.

TS DOST Admission Fees

- The fees for filling the TS DOST admission application is INR 200/- for any of the six universities
- The web options will be available across the universities with prioritizing option as well
- The biometric verification is available in collaboration with each and every eseva centers in Telangana state.

TS DOST Admission Procedure 2019

The TS DOST Admission Process is quite simple and short; here comes a quick glimpse regarding same

- **The allotment of seats will be on the basis of student's priority and grades achieved**
- **It is preferred that every student gets admission according to their priority**
- **After that the candidate is in need of downloading the allotment letter which will be available on official website.**

Follow Below Steps to Apply Online for TS DOST 2019 Online Application at dost.cgg.gov.in

One of the most asked questions about DOST is how to enroll ourselves under it. Well here are the steps to be followed for getting enrolled

- Open the Official Website (Link Given in the Table).
- At homepage, You will be Seeing Logos of Six Universities and Instructions Regarding each one of them.
- There, hit the “**REGISTER**” Button.
- You can check the “**UG Online Admission Payment Option Form**” will show up; will the form and submit it.
- Head Forward and Pay the Fee of Filling the Form.
- The Payment Gateway will Appear (**Enter the Card Details and Pay the Fee**).
- Once you have paid the Applications Fee; **Application Number** will appear on the screen (note it down) along with SMS on the Registered Number
- Now you will be Getting a Form that You need to Fill with 100% Authentic Details.

- Fill the details > **Go** through it Once again > **Submit** the form
