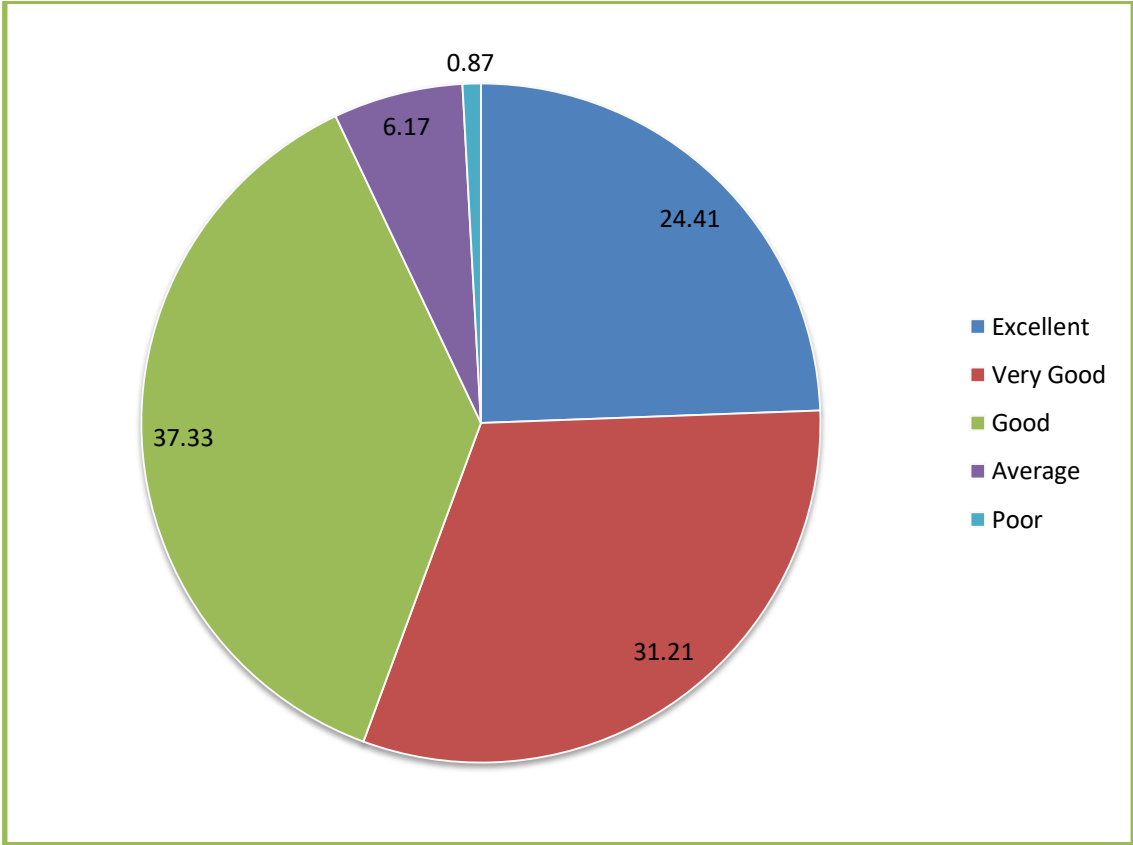

ANALYSIS OF THE STUDENT SATISFACTORY SURVEY – 2017-18

The state government of Telangana through Commissioner of Collegiate Education (CCE) issued a common student feedback form with 20 questions having 5 options for each question, i.e. Excellent, Very good, Good, Average and Poor. The feedback form has been served to students and collected their opinion. The main objective of feedback is to correct the shortfalls and improve the quality of teaching and learning activity. Feedback from 120 students has been collected and the responses are tabled and analyzed, as follows;

1. 100 percent syllabus coverage- is the first question for which 30 students replied excellent, 38 said very good, 50 said good, 2 said average and no one replied as poor. Almost 98 percent expressed a good opinion.
2. Efforts in generating interest- is the second question for which 20 replied as excellent, 38 replied very good, 55 good, 6 replied average and 1 replied as poor. This means the teacher is generating interest.
3. Clarity of expression- for which 23 percent opined excellent, 33 percent opined very good, 37 percent opined good, 7 percent opined average and no one opined poor. It says that there is good clarity of expression.
4. Subject content- for which 35 said excellent, 37 said very good, 43 said good, 2 said average and only 1 said poor. The subject content was apt.
5. Information on latest development in the subject-20.8 percent said excellent, 30 percent said very good, 42 percent opined good, 5.8 percent said average and 1.6 percent opined poor. The latest developments are being included in teaching.
6. Using innovative methods of teaching-21 opined excellent, 43 opined very good, 49 opined good, 4 opined average and 3 opined poor, which means majority positive on the using the innovative methods.
7. Interaction with students-41 said excellent, 29 said very good, 46 said good 3 said average and only 1 said poor.
8. Use of teaching models-29 members opined excellent, 41 said very good, 42 said good, 6 said average and 2 said poor.
9. Guidance in student study project-26 percent of the students opined excellent, 33 percent said very good, 7.5 percent said good and no one said poor. It means there is proper guidance for student study projects.
10. Aptitude in conducting extension activities- 22 members said excellent, 34 said very good, 48 said good, 15 said average and only one said poor.
11. Motivation to use Library and internet-36 opined excellent, 39 said very good, 38 said good, 6 said average and one said poor.
12. Guidance in student seminar-34 said excellent, 34 said very good, 43 said good, 9 said average and no one said poor.
13. Valuation of answer scripts and discussion-22 opined excellent, 39 said very good, 46 said good, 12 said average and only one said poor.
14. Remedial coaching and preparation for annual examination-21 students opined excellent, 37 opined very good, 47 opined good, 12 said average and 3 said poor.

15. Regularity and Punctuality-30 opined excellent, 36 said very good, 45 said good, 7 opined average and 2 said poor.
16. Guidance in co-curricular activities-38 said excellent, 30 opined very good, 40 said good, 10 said average and 2 opined poor.
17. Counseling and career guidance-28 opined excellent, 42 opined very good, 41 said good, 9 said average and no said poor.
18. Academic interaction beyond class room-21 students said excellent, 44 said very good, 47 said good, 7said average and one said poor.
19. Concern for students-28 opined excellent, 37 said very good, 46 said good, 9 said average and no one said poor.
20. Overall opinion-46 students opined excellent, 36 said very good, 34 said good, 4 said average and no one said poor.

On an average 29 students opined excellent, 37 opined very good, 45 opined good, 7 said average and only opined poor. Hence most of the students opined favourable.
