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Government Degree College, Narsampet was established on 3rd December, 1984 in Warangal District of united Andhra Pradesh. Narsampet is a major town located 45 Kilometers away from District headquarters. The college is affiliated to Kakatiya University, Warangal and it was admitted by UGC under 2(f) & 12(B) in 1991. The goal of the institution is to provide higher education to the socially, economically, and downtrodden sections of the society.

After formation of separate Telangana State on 2nd June 2014 and reorganization of new Districts in October 2016, Government Degree College, Narsampet is conferred as **Identified College of Warangal Rural District. The other two colleges come under this District are Govt. Degree College, Parkal and Govt. Degree College, Wardhannapet.**

Lt. Dr. B. Chandramouli, Principal of Govt. Degree College, Narsampet conducts quarterly District Resource Center (DRC) meetings as per the instructions of the Commissioner of Collegiate Education, Telangana to improve the quality education and over all progress of the students as well as the colleges.
