Rain water harvesting:

Government Degree College, Narsampet takes all possible measures to preserve the rain water. The institution has a built in water harvesting and flood water management through pits. There are several other benefits such as reducing erosion of ground, flooding around the building and raising the water table.

There are Rain Water Pits dug around the campus to recharge the ground water. The groundwater thus gets recharged facilitating in the increase of the ground water table. The best part of digging such pits is there is no shortage of water in the Well and Borewell of the College. This facilitates in gardening and even in peak of summer the College has lush greenery providing not only fresh air for the staff and students but also to the morning walkers coming to Government Degree College, Narsampet.

The college is situated in a low lying area with elevated roads and residential areas around. As such, every drop of water running down the uplands is likely to flow into the college ground. Especially, during the rainy season, a lot of rain water floods the campus from all directions.

The College has proper water distribution system in the entire campus with Over head tanks, water sump to store the water. Taps are fitted in the toilets, washrooms, Laboratories.
