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## PEER TEAM RECOMMENDATIONS OF CYCLE2 DATED 04-03-2015

### RECOMMENDATIONS FOR QUALITY ENHANCEMENT OF THE INSTITUTION

#### **1. Introduction of more restructured and add-on courses should be the priority**

The college introduced a greater number of add-on courses w.e.f. 2015-16 as mentioned in Criterion-I 1.2.2 of SSR. Further, the college started two PG Courses 1. M.A. TELUGU from 2015-16 and 2. M.A. ENGLISH from 2016-17.

#### **2. Adequate Non-Teaching and Laboratory staff to be sought from the Government**

The Non-teaching Staff was appointed by the Commissioner of Collegiate Education, Telangana. Two new posts of Superintendent and Administrative Officer were sanctioned in 2018 and the non-teaching staff strengthened as mentioned in Criterion II 2.4.1.

#### **3. More regular teaching staff be sought from government**

More Regular teaching faculty joined on 30-06- 2018 comprising 90% regular teaching faculty as mentioned in 2.2.2 & 2.4.1.

#### **4. To augment the physical infrastructure particularly lab and furniture by mobilizing the resources from external agencies.**

The Physical Infrastructure was augmented w.e.f. 2015-16. The following were set up in the college vide sanction of the Commissioner of Collegiate Education, Telangana s

1. English Language Lab, 2. TSKC Lab, 3. Digital Library, 4. Virtual Classroom and 5. Sports Track.

In addition, the District Collector and Magistrate Smt. M. Haritha, IAS sanctioned required furniture to Digital Lab in 2018-19, constructed Girls Toilet Block, ground levelling fund, and 100 dual desks.

The college has been renovated with an amount of Rs.21.60 Lakh from the accumulated funds sanctioned by the CCE TS in 2020.

#### **5. Adoption of ICT for teaching be further encouraged by strengthening ICT infrastructure.**

The above Digital tools besides, T-SAT, LCD Projectors and Digital rooms, 88 computers, 4 laptops and Printers fulfil the ICT requirements of the teaching faculty.

#### **6. Steps may be initiated to provide hostel facilities for boys and girls by tapping resources from UGC/State Government and other national agencies.**

Proposals for construction of Girls Hostel were submitted to the CCE TS and the District Collector. The Girls Hostel to college is expected soon.

**7. A separate placement cell may be established with the help of the faculty by allocating sufficient resources**

The Career and Counselling Cell established a separate placement cell in addition to Innovation and Incubation Centre and EDC in order to train the students in Employability and Entrepreneur skills.

**8. Necessary initiatives may be taken to add NCC unit for boys.**

Proposals for establishment of NCC Boys Unit submitted and it was assured to sanction the Boys Unit to college in due course of time. NCC Boys Unit is expected soon.

**9. More facilities for Outdoor/Indoor games may be created and staff be provided.**

The Sports track for 100/200/1000 Mts. track was set up for District level sports and games. Indoor games like chess, carroms, shuttle, etc are procured.

**10. The campus may be spruced up by greening the Surrounding space and providing additional facilities to create a good academic environment.**

The college has set up a beautiful garden in its premises. As per the instructions of Govt. of Telangana, mega plantation drive was taken up from the year 2014 under the programme 'Telanganaku Haritha Haram'. The mango groves and other plants and trees give a nature look to college as 50% of the land is with greenery.
